Tonight is our first regular Club night at AWANA. Here are a few reminders and clarifications:

New to our Large Group Counsel time this year is a short Bible story from the Jesus Storybook Bible. Sparks will review this story as part of their Small Group Handbook time in addition to the lesson where they look up Bible verses and answer questions (the Jesus Storybook Bible activity sheet is on the back page of the lesson). T&T Groups will work only on their T&T books, however should any of your Clubbers have any questions about the Bible Story, a Jesus Storybook Bible is in each class tote for reference.

The classroom each group meets in for Small Group Handbook time is in parenthesis on the list below based on what the sign says outside the classroom door for Sunday School (disregard any mention on the signs for Awana – we haven't updated the signs yet.)

Each Classroom will have a labeled tote with the Handbooks for each Clubber, a new Bible for each Clubber, pencil box and folder with point sheets for each Clubber in your group (there are also a few blank sheets for any new Clubbers). When filling out point sheets for this week, also give each Clubber who came last week 4 points for week 1 (Sept 14) or 5 points, if they brought a guest who has never attended Awana before. If you have any questions about point sheets, please see Jenny Buehler.

There is a cart in the Sunday School opening room with additional supplies, handbooks and Bibles should you find you don't have enough of what you need in the totes in your classroom.

Large Group Agendas (lists of songs, Jesus Storybook Bible Story, Teacher and memory verses) will be available at the Registration table. T&T Leaders will need this to know which weeks the memory verses listed in the Handbooks have been changed.

Awana shirts for Clubbers are ready and we will pass them out at the end of Club. If they would like, Clubbers can wear their t-shirts each week, however it is not a required uniform. Encourage them to wear them outside of Awana to share with others and invite friends to come to Awana. We do have a few Sparks vests and T&T shirts left if there are any Clubbers who don't have the more traditional uniform and would like to wear one each week.
